Jasmine is the owner of Diedrich Espresso, a 20-location coffee stand chain in the North Sound area of Washington State, just north of Seattle. Of course, there's another notable coffee shop chain from Seattle. The most important thing to Jasmine is highlighting what makes her operation different. We did that by instilling in her announcements a sense of fun while showcasing the charitable giving that her company facilitates. Diedrich Espresso doesn't have the capacity or the resources that Starbucks has, but our messaging positions Diedrich as a coffee stand you *want* to support.
